

PROGRAM INFORMATION

The **Doctors Of Tomorrow**

(D.O.T.) program is a county-wide educational program run by the Suffolk Academy of Medicine. We provide personal, firsthand, and encouraging information to high school students on what it takes to become a doctor and a leader in the community. The program consists of an introductory symposium, an essay contest, a day with a doctor, networking events, community engagement, and more.



INTRODUCTORY SYMPOSIUM

There will be two symposium sessions available, both in-person and virtually. A distinguished panel will outline the program requirements. Qualifying high school Juniors and Seniors should contact us at doctorsoftomorrow@scms-sam.org to register for either of the symposiums.

ATTENDANCE TO ONE OF THE SYMPOSIUM SESSIONS IS MANDATORY

APPLICATION PROCESS

The application for both Juniors and Seniors consists of an essay and a list of extracurricular activities. All interested high school Juniors and Seniors are required to submit an essay of approximately 200 words on the topic:

"The Major Influence Which Contributed to My Desire to Become A Physician."

Entries are judged on originality, composition, and style. Along with the essay, students will need to provide a list of extracurricular activities, such as work, sports, awards, clubs, etc. The submission deadline for the application will be

EDITH FRIEDMAN SCHOLARSHIP

This \$300 scholarship will be awarded to a Junior and Senior with outstanding community service.

ROBERT A. SCHER, M.D. SCHOLARSHIP

This \$200 scholarship will be awarded to a Junior and Senior who have demonstrated a keen interest in school or local government and politics.

\$1000 TUITION SCHOLARSHIP

Three participating **SENIORS** will be selected for this scholarship. \$1,000 will be paid to each of the winners upon matriculation to medical school. The Academy also selects three alternates to receive this \$1,000 scholarship in the event scholarship winners do not matriculate.

The Society will contact the Guidance Office to request the required academic packet (a letter of recommendation, transcripts, and SAT/ACT scores) for seniors interested in this scholarship.
